EXOTIC PRE-ANESTHETIC CONSENT FORM

PRE-ANESTHETIC BLOOD TESTING: Like you, our greatest concern is the well-being of your pet. Our doctor will perform a full physical examination prior to anesthesia, but many conditions cannot be detected with an exam alone. Our in-house laboratory will provide rapid results regarding's your pet's internal organ health prior to the anesthetic procedure. If there are any abnormalities, we will call you to discuss it before anesthesia is administered. Please keep in mind, it is not possible for every species to have pre-op blood work (as will be discussed by the doctor).

- (initial) YES**, I approve pre-operative blood work for my pet.
 0-3 years of age: CBC & mini chemistry blood profile **\$125.00**
 >3 years of age: CBC & full chemistry blood profile **\$155.00**
 (initial) NO, I decline pre-operative blood work for my pet.

MICROCHIP IMPLANTATION: Implanting a HOME AGAIN microchip requires a large needle and is ideally performed while your pet is already under anesthesia. Please indicate your choice below:

- (initial) YES**, I want my pet to be implanted with the Home AGAIN microchip. **\$58.00**
 (initial) NO, I decline to have my pet implanted with the Home AGAIN microchip.

CHEST X-RAY (PRE-ANESTHESIA): Prior to anesthesia, it is safest to perform chest x-rays. These x-rays allow us to evaluate your pet's heart size and evidence of metastatic lung cancer, as well as other pathology. This test is recommended for all pets, but **STRONGLY** recommended for all pets over the age of 6 years.

- (initial) YES**, I want x-rays. **\$195.00**
 (initial) NO, I decline x-rays at this time.

POST-OPERATIVE NUTRITION: Many exotic species have a decreased appetite for several days after anesthesia. We advise having a supply of food (Oxbow Critical Care) that can be fed by a syringe in an emergency.

- (initial) YES**, I would like to purchase a bag of Oxbow Critical Care \$18.
 (initial) NO, I do not want a bag of Oxbow Critical Care.

RHDV2 VACCINATION: Rabbit hemorrhagic disease virus is a very serious contagious disease that can cause death. We advise that all rabbits are vaccinated for it regardless of whether they live in or outside.

- (initial) YES**, I would like my rabbit to receive the RHDV2 vaccine (\$32, a series of two vaccinations separated by 3-4 weeks).
 (initial) NO, I do not want my rabbit to be vaccinated.
